The Principal explains that in 2019-2020, one primary school teacher resident position has not been filled because on two occasions the teachers applying for it have not been seconded. The post has therefore been frozen.

The AEFE then proposed to the Principal to change the job map for 2021-2022 by creating a post of expatriate EMFE (Teacher Master-Trainer within the establishment) instead of the post of resident primary school teacher.

In the context of the enrolment growth of the school, apart from this particular year marked by COVID, the EMFE post will allow the training of future teachers under local contracts, in collaboration with the Headmistress. This is a mark of confidence from the AEFE which supports our dynamic.
