- Philosophy post n° 11391: request for closure as 31 August 2025

The philosophy teacher has only 4 hours of teaching in this subject this year and will at best only have 8 hours in subsequent years.

A new French Literature Teacher on secondment, trained to teach philosophy and already working in the AEFÉ network, has been recruited for the next three years.

Mme Dauer asked the AEFÉ to convert the philosophy post into a modern literature position. Mme Dauer explained that the refusal was justified because 3 out of 4 of the teachers on secondment were already teaching this subject.

Bridging class:

Reasons for the request:

Mrs Dauer and Alliès explained their proposal to open a bridge class for fully English-speaking students between Years 6 and 7 at the college. This would attract new English-speaking students and introduce the school to families who would not otherwise consider a French high school for their child.



- How it works:

Intensive course in French during the first year, with some immersion classes. 2 to 3 key subjects with gradual integration as progress is made. Teaching can be provided by a multi-disciplinary, skills-based primary school teacher.

- Promotion of this programme:

Build a close relationship with schools up to CM2, which have high tuition fees.

Encourage parents and board members to promote the programme for the new academic year.

At the start of the new school year, English-speaking students must not be turned down, but this programme must be offered instead.

VOTE ON THE CREATION OF A PASSEREL CLASS SYSTEM IN SECONDARY SCHOOL: 12 in favour
